



## Science Fair Coordinator Grant

**Who is Eligible:** Any public or private school K-12 teacher or certified science/technology support staff within the region supported by the Flint Regional Science Fair (Genesee, Lapeer, Shiawassee, St. Clair, and Tuscola counties).

**Purpose of Science Fair Coordinator:** This person will promote the science fair in his/her district or system (including partnering schools) at the elementary, middle school and high school level, including the participation of at least five students with senior (high school) level projects at the science fair this school year. The 59<sup>th</sup> Annual Flint Regional Science Fair will be held at Kettering University on March 20, 21 and 23, 2015.

The Flint Regional Science Fair Board will provide support and guidance for the grant recipients.

**Additional Requirements:** All grant recipients will be required to attend a grant recipient meeting, date to be determined. Also, all recipients must attend the Flint Regional Science Fair, including the awards ceremony on Sunday, March 23, 2015.

**Award:** \$1,000 (multiple grants are available). Review and determination of winning grant proposals will be in early October. Grant recipients will receive \$500 within two weeks of award, and \$500 at the completion of all requirements. Funds are to be used to promote and support science fair activities, including reimbursement for teacher's time and expenses.

**Application:** Complete the attached application and return it to the Flint Regional Science Fair board by November 30, 2014.
