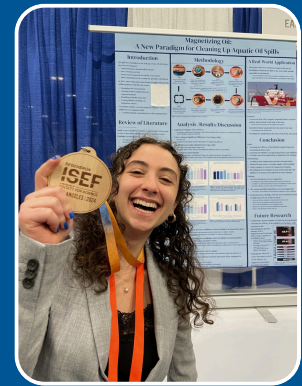

The FRSEF works with the greater community to serve students: (550+ in 2024)

- Grades 3-12 from public, private, charter and home schools
- Flint, Saginaw, Midland, Lansing, Port Huron, Traverse City and across mid-Michigan
- Provide teachers with resources and the tools to enable experiential STEM
- **Elementary Fair:** Sloan Museum of Discovery, Grades 3-5
 - Field Trip + Science Fair, awards at the Longway Planetarium
- **Middle + High School Fair:** UM-Flint, Grades 6-12
 - 5 students receive all-expense paid trip + mentorship for the International Science and Engineering Fair + 2 students to GENIUS Olympiad
- **Outreach:** events provide opportunities to students out of science fair
 - Flint Firebirds STEAM Night, Coding Workshops

Flint Regional vs Everybody

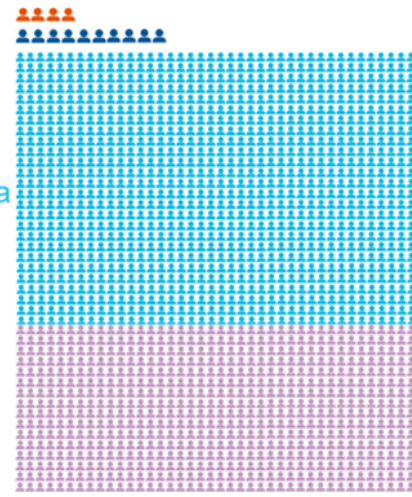
The top placing projects at the FRSEF directly qualify to compete at the **International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF)** and GENIUS Olympiad.
