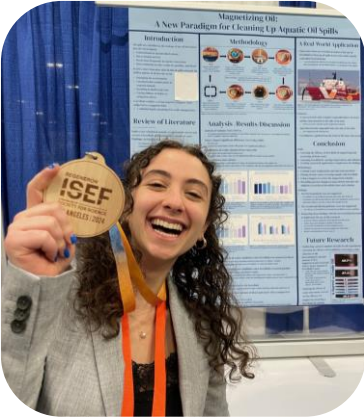

Your support of the Flint Regional Science & Engineering Fair fosters an environment that challenges students to engage in critical thinking and problem solving—skills that are crucial to the world’s future.

The FRSEF works with the greater community to serve students: (550+ in 2024)

- Grades 3-12 from public, private, charter, and home schools
- Flint, Saginaw, Midland, Lansing, Port Huron and across mid-Michigan
- Provide teachers with resources and the tools to enable experiential STEM
- **Elementary Fair: Sloan Museum of Discovery**, Grades 3-5
  - Field trip + science fair, awards at the Longway Planetarium
- **Middle + High School Fair: UM-Flint**, Grades 6-12.
  - 4 students receive all-expense trip + mentorship for the International Science and Engineering Fair.
- **Outreach:** events provide opportunities to students outside of science fair
  - Flint Firebirds STEAM Night, Coding and Electronics Workshops

## FLINT REGIONAL vs EVERYBODY

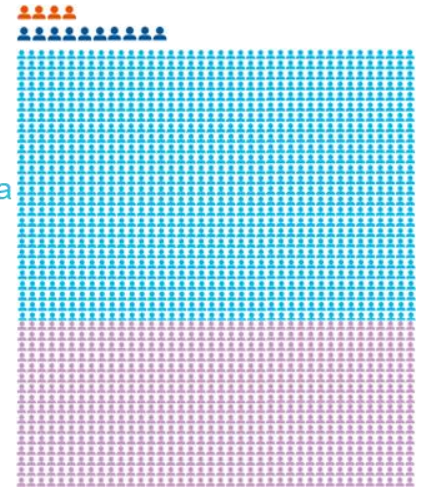
The top placing projects at the FRSEF directly qualify to compete at the **International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF)**.

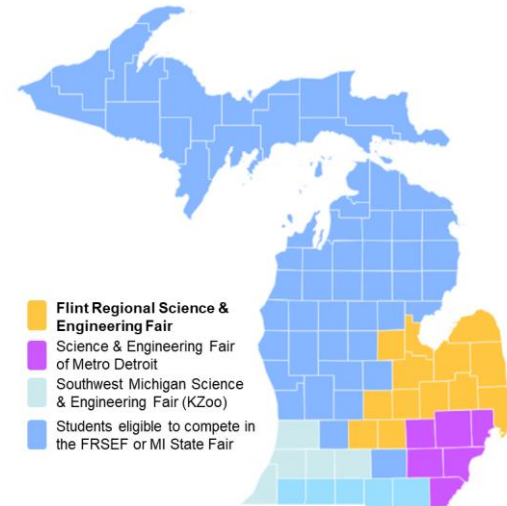
